Opposite:

boring

EXCITING

Examples:

- A new and exciting journey is waiting for us.
- Your idea is very exciting.
- I can't wait do it again, it was an exciting experience.
- It would be so exciting when the get married.

Similar: thrilling exhilarating stirring rousing stimulating intoxicating electrifying invigorating moving inspiring gripping compelling sensational powerful dramatic shocking startling hair-raising explosive knife-edge mind-blowing edge-of-the-seat stem-winding

Opposite:

boring
